Summer Staff Dress code

As camp counselors and interns you set the standard for the kids. Your kind interaction with one another and service are going to impact these campers. You are leaving an impression on the parents we serve who are entrusting the care of their child to you for 8+ hours per day. Your modest dress may affect their future choices too. While we are not going to require a uniform we are going to require modesty and a considerate attitude toward campers and staff. In order to accomplish this we are imposing the following standard of dress.

- i. Loose comfortable clothing (shirts, skirts, shorts, pants)
- ii. No “Knotted” in the back shirts.
- iii. Shirts must cover the entire torso and not allow midriffs or belly buttons to show even when arms are raised.
- iv. No spaghetti straps, halter, tube or tank tops.
- v. Undergarments should not rise above the waist band of pants.
- vi. No writing on buttocks of clothing.
- vii. All clothing logos or slogans must be appropriate and cannot advertise anything that might be construed as contrary to Christianity.(i.e. secular rock bands)
- viii. Boy’s pants need to stay up. (no saggy bottom boys)
- ix. No short shorts, mini-skirts or low cut clothing.
- x. Shorts must have a minimum inseam of 7”. (Good thing Bermudas’ are back in)
- xi. Girls: one piece bathing suits only.
- xii. Shirts & shorts must be worn when en route to and from the pool area.

Camp T-shirt must be worn every Monday & fieldtrip days so that you are easily recognized as a leader with our camp. You may not alter the t-shirt in ANYWAY and it must be worn as issued. (Ladies no “knots” in the back to make it tighter)

Make sure you follow the Bible’s dress code. You didn’t know the Bible had a dress code, did you?
“Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.” (Colossians 3:12) Let your heart attire be more noticeable than your outward appearance.
